Sanction Review Panels: The Panels are comprised of 3-5 teens who review the completion efforts of former offenders. Panel participation is by **INVITE ONLY**. Prospective panelists need to attend at least 3 hearing sessions as regular jurors before serving as a Sanction Review Panelist.
