New Student Volunteers: High school student participants who have not previously been trained for the program (either through school or by other means) will be required to attend a training session. Trainings are offered every 4th Wednesday after the Sanction Review Panels are completed. If you or someone you know would like to be trained, please call the Teen Court office and leave your name, phone number and a brief message expressing your interest in being trained. You will be contacted before the next training session.

Sanction Review Panels: The Panels are comprised of 3-5 students that review the completion efforts of former offenders. Prospective panelists need to attend at least 3 hearing sessions as regular jurors before serving as a Sanction Review Panelist.
